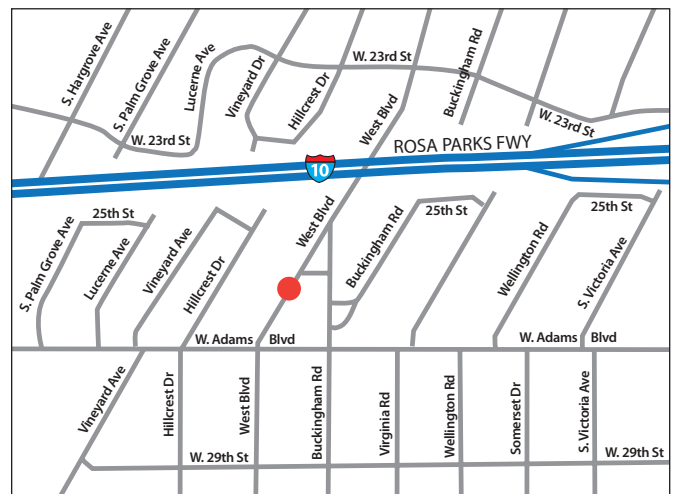
The "SCAN Van" features state-of-the-art technology; educational resources; and senior-focused, *on-board activities such as brain fitness programs, virtual bowling and more.*
